



There are four types of Working for Families payments.

You may qualify for more than one payment type, depending on your personal situation.

Best start tax credit

A payment for families supporting a newborn baby.

If you qualify for Best Start you'll receive the payment until your child turns one - no matter what your family earns. You could continue to receive Best Start payments until your child turns three, but this will depend on what your family earns.

Best Start payments begin once paid parental leave finishes.

In-work tax credit

A payment for qualifying families who have some income from paid work each week, with no minimum hours of work required.

Like the family tax credit, this payment depends on how much your family earns.

If you're receiving an income-tested benefit or a student allowance you will not qualify for this payment.

Minimum family tax credit

A payment to make sure qualifying low-income families get a minimum level of income.

The parent, parents, or caregivers need to work a required number of hours for salary and wages.

A single parent must work at least 20 hours a week. In a two-parent family or other family structure, one or both parents between them must work at least 30 hours a week.

If you're receiving an income-tested benefit you will not qualify for this payment.

Family tax credit

A payment to help qualifying families with the costs of raising children.

This payment depends on how much your family earns, the number of dependent children you have, and any shared care arrangements.

If you receive an income-tested benefit you may also qualify for this payment. In this case, Work and Income will usually pay you the family tax credit.



Whiwhinga tāke tīmata pai rawa

He utu mā ngā whānau e tautoko ana i tētahi pēpi hou.

Mēnā e āhei ana koe ki te Tīmata Pai Rawa ka whiwhi koe i te utu tae noa ki te ekenga o tō tamaiti ki te kotahi tau – ahakoa te nui o ngā moni whiwhi a tō whānau.

Ka taea te whiwhi tonu ngā utu Tīmata Pai Rawa tae noa ki te ekenga o tō tamaiti ki te toru tau, engari kei runga tēnei i ngā moni whiwhi a tō whānau.

Ka tīmata ngā utu Tīmata Pai Rawa ina mutu ngā utu whakamatuatanga tiaki pēpi.

Whiwhinga tāke mahi

Ko tētahi utu mā ngā whānau e āhei ana kei te utua mai i ngā mahi i ia wiki, kāore he here haora mahi iti rawa.

Pērā i te whiwhinga tāke whānau, kei te nui o ngā moni whiwhi a tō whānau.

Mēnā kei te whiwhi koe i tētahi takuhe kua whakamātautautia te moni whiwhi, tahua tautoko ākonga rānei, kāore koe e āhei atu ki tēnei utu.

He whiwhinga tāke mōkiti mō te whānau

He utu hei whakarite ka whiwhi ngā whānau iti te moni whiwhi i tētahi rahinga moni whiwhi mōkiti.

Me otī i te matua, ngā mātua, ngā kaitiaki rānei i ētahi haora kua whakaritea mō te utu ā-tau me ngā utu ā-haora.

Me mātua otī i tētahi matua takakau ngā haora mahi e 20 i te wiki i te iti rawa.

I tētahi whānau e rua ngā mātua, tētahi atu hanganga whānau rānei, me mātua otī i tētahi matua, ngā mea e rua rānei te 30 haora i te wiki i te iti rawa.

Mēnā kei te whiwhi koe i tētahi takuhe kua whakamātautautia te moni whiwhi kāore koe e āhei atu ki tēnei utu.

Whiwhinga tāke whānau

He utu hei āwhina i ngā whānau e āhei ana me ngā utu o te whakatipu tamariki.

Kei te nui o ngā moni whiwhi a tō whānau tēnei utu, te maha o ngā tamariki e tiakina ana e koe, me ngā whakaritenga tiaki tamariki me ētahi atu.

Mēnā ka whiwhi koe i tētahi takuhe kua whakamātautautia te moni whiwhi ka āhei anō pea koe ki tēnei utu.

I tēnei āhuatanga, i te nuinga o te wā ka utua e Te Hiranga Tangata tētahi whiwhinga tāke whānau ki a koe.
